

# **NAVAJO MOUNTAIN HIGH SCHOOL**

## **PARENT POLICY 2018-2019**

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Parents and students are welcome and should feel comfortable to become partners in the educational process with teachers and administrators.

Parents will be instructed in the Student Information System (Aspire) that provides access to student progress concerning grades, assignments, attendance, and transcript review.

Parents will be provided a student and parent handbook to inform families of the school calendar, expectations, general information, and district policies.

Parent information will be provided to learn strategies for school success.

Parents will be informed that students will be served best with High School and beyond to be prepared for a successful future.

At least four times per year, counselor meetings will be scheduled with each student to review classes and transcripts. Needed adjustments will be made when necessary. Parents will be invited to attend a minimum of one meeting, but are always welcome to participate or initiate any type of conference at anytime.

Progress reports with attendance will be mailed home two times a quarter. Quarterly report cards will be mailed to the home each quarter.

An aggressive public relations effort is conducted with a monthly newsletter to announce school events and plans, to present useful information to parents, and to celebrate the achievements of students, staff, and the school.

School Community Council meetings are held to discuss school progress and provide an avenue for parents to have a voice concerning the efforts of the school.

JOM meetings are conducted to determine the needs of the students and families.

Home visits are made to provide information and check on student attendance.

Students are given a grade level Advisor who will stay with that grade level cohort group of students through graduation. This provides academic support and a way to for each student to feel connected to school.
