Parents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To be informed of district policy and school rules and regulations • To visit school periodically and to participate in conferences with teachers ,counselor, or administration regarding the academic and behavioral status of their children • To inspect their child's school records, particularly attendance and grades • To be informed of significant facts and school action related to the student's behavior and academic progress • To examine their child's personal records 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To make sure their children attend school regularly and on time, have adequate sleep and nutrition, practice personal hygiene, and wear appropriate clothing • To call or send a note to excuse their child no later than the day following the absence • To be familiar with district policy and school rules and regulations • To provide the school with a current phone number where a parent or responsible adult may be reached at all times • To actively participate in efforts to improve their child's behavior or attendance • To make provisions for off-campus care for the student in the case of suspension, illness, or accident • To regularly (at least every two weeks) check their child's attendance records and inform the school of any mistakes • To return to the school all required documentation and correspondence
